Some thoughts about technology and education

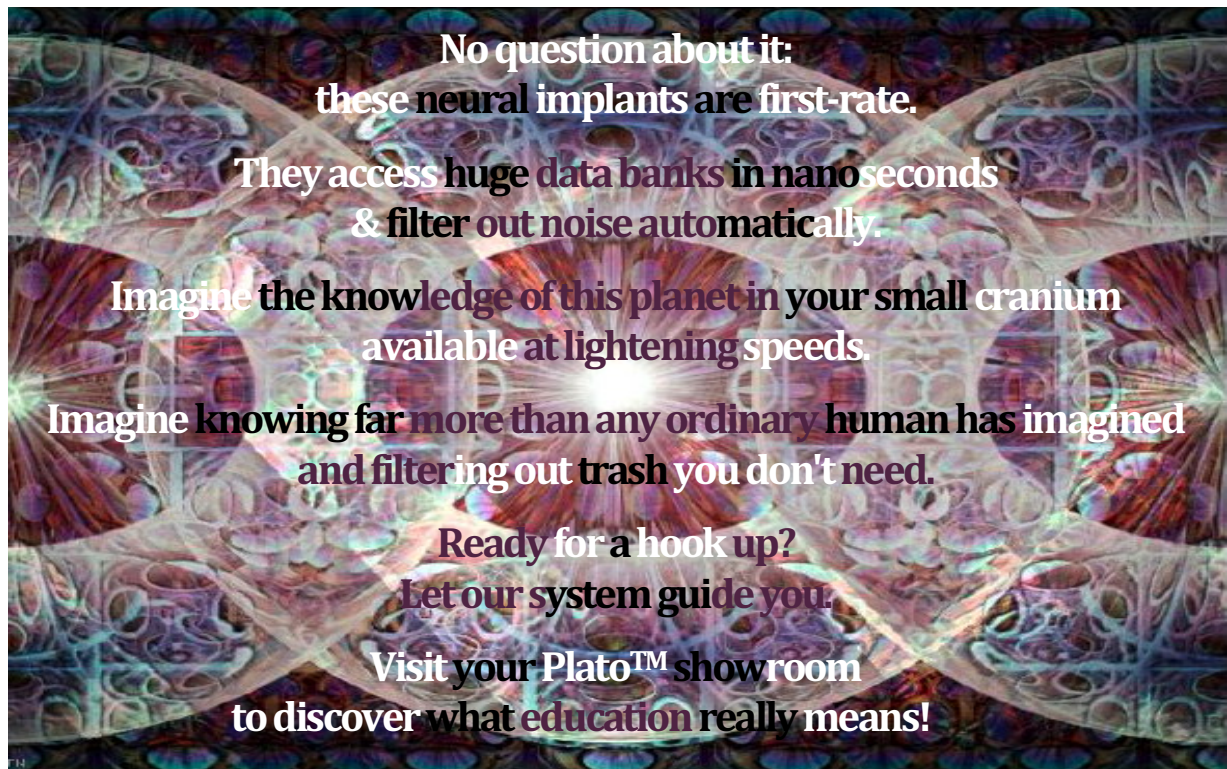
Liao: Aren't we too fascinated with technology?
