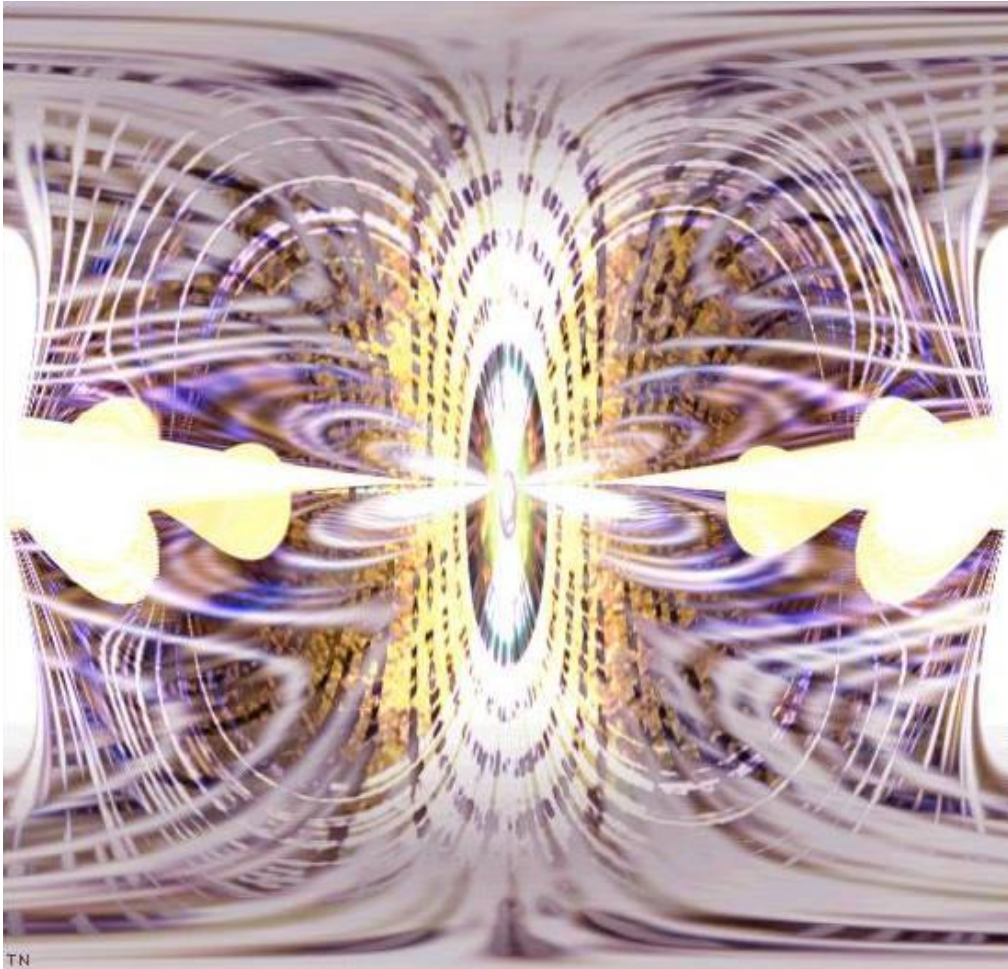


How Weird: Out of the Box of Expectations
