Some Thoughts about Art & Peace

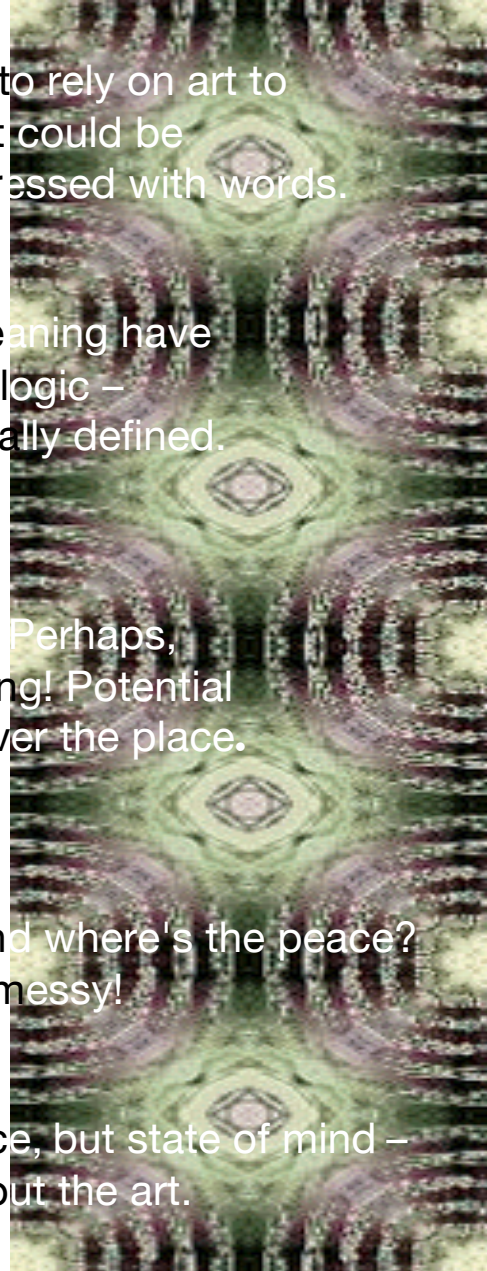
Frida: This author seems to rely on art to communicate what could be more logically expressed with words.
