THE XYZS OF LOVE:

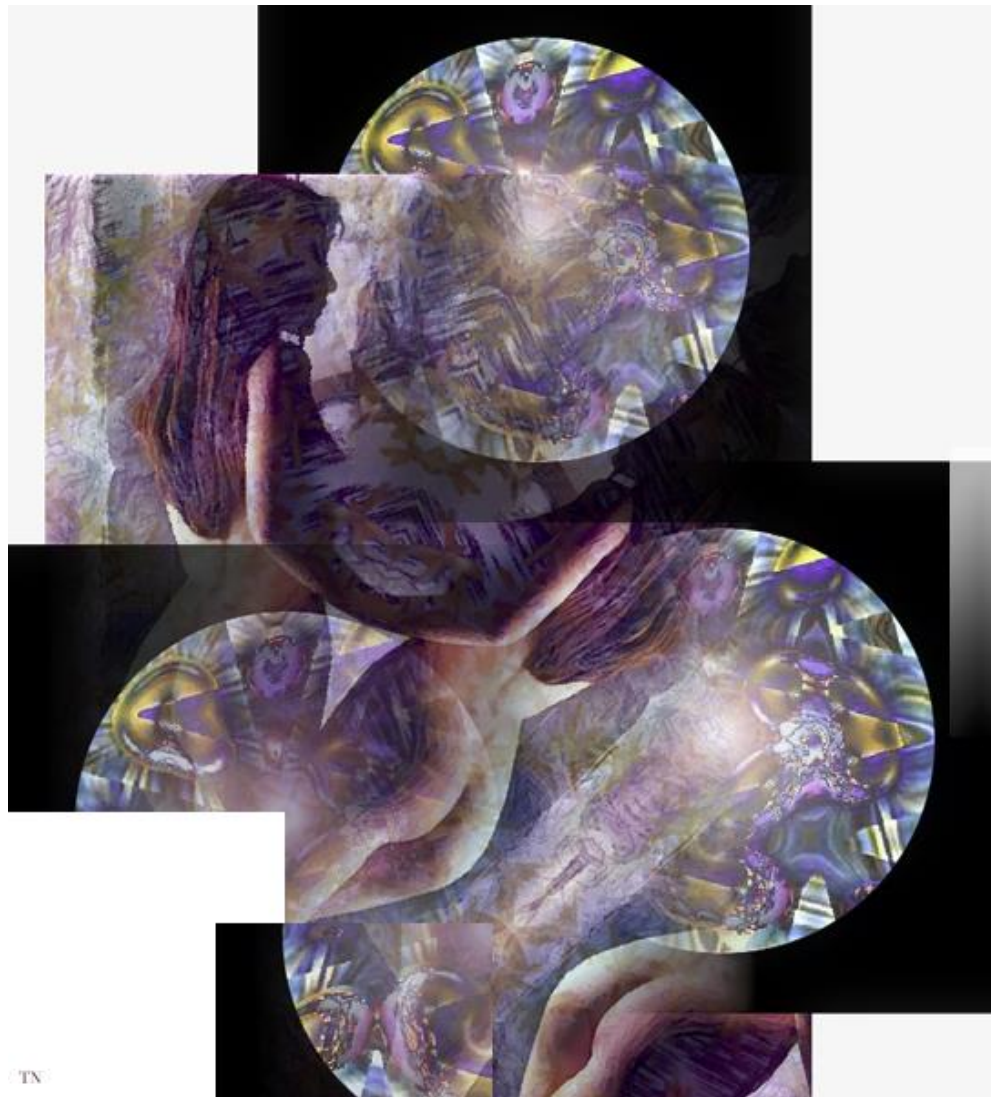
Some Hyper-Hormoned Nonsense
